Kate Shawl

Materials

KnitWise de All You Knit is Love - 100% Alpaca, 220m/100g

Color A 30-Romesco (1 skein), Color B 11-Gerd (1 skein)

4.5mm circular needles

Stitch marker

Tapestry needle

Gauge

16sts=10cm in blocked Stockinette stitch

Glossary

k = knit

p = purl

RS = right side

WS = wrong side

PM = place marker

sl1 = slip 1 stitch (purlwise unless indicated otherwise)

sl1wyif = slip 1 stitch purlwise with the yarn in front

k2tog = knit 2 stitches together (right leaning decrease)

ssk = slip 1 stitch knitwise, slip 1 stitch purlwise, with the left needle go into the front of those 2 stitches and knit them together (left leaning decrease)

sl2-k-ssso = slip 2 stitches together knitwise, knit 1 stitch, pass the slipped stitches over the knit stitch (centered double decrease)

Tip

To make the stripes line up at the edges, knit the first stitch of each row and then slip the last stitch of each row with the yarn in front. You can see a good video here by Gnarled Paw <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=dS6a0v43Jj8>.

Instructions

Cast on and solid section

Using Color A, cast on 3 sts

Knit 7 rows

Without turning, pick up and knit 3sts along long edge of the piece and 3 more along the cast on edge. *(9sts)*

Continuing with Color A, work as follows:

WS 1) k3, p to last 3 stitches, k2, sl1wyif

RS 2) k3, yo, k1, yo, PM, k1, yo, k1, yo, k2, sl1wyif *(13sts)*

3) k3, p to last 3 stitches, k2, sl1wyif

4) k3, yo, knit to marker, yo, k1, yo, k to last 3 stitches, yo, k2, sl1wyif *(17sts)*

5) k3, p to last 3 stitches, k2, sl1wyif

Work rows 4) and 5) until you have **61sts** in total..

Stripes

Change to Color B and work as established above (alternating rows 4 and 5) for 2 rows.

Change to Color A and work as established above (alternating rows 4 and 5) for 2 rows.

Continue like this, alternating between Color A and Color B every 2 rows until you have **249sts** in total.

Using only Color B, work the Edge Chart once, ending on a WS row.

Work 2 rows in garter stitch.

BO all sts and weave in ends. I used a stretchy bind off like the one shown in this video by Sweet Georgia <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=w0VbPIVY-K0>.

Block the shawl to open up the lace edging.

EDGE CHART

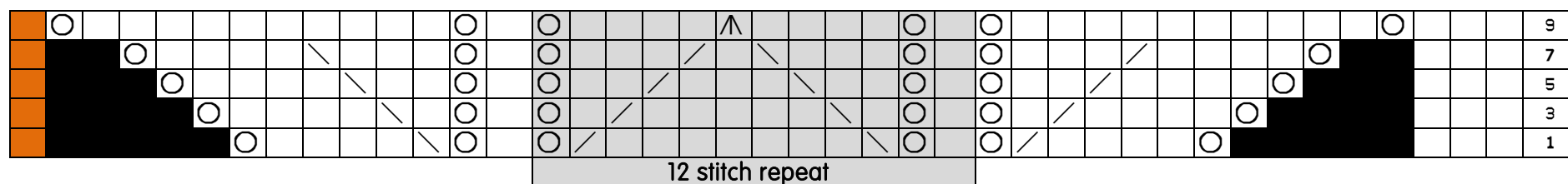


Chart made with the free Font Kauri Knits

- The chart is worked in the standard manner: you start from right to left, work the repeat 9 times and continue until you get to the **center stitch**, then you work back from left to right, reversing the shaping (the k2tog are worked as ssk and the ssk are worked as k2tog).
- The even/WS rows are worked: 3k, purl to the last 3 sts, 2k, sl1wyif.
