

Trifàsic



MATERIALS & INFO

Yarn: **k2tog by All You Knit is Love**
(100m/100gr) - 2 skeins MC, 1 skein CC

Gauge: 6 brioche "stripes" unblocked = 10
cm (gauge is not crucial for this project)

Needles: 5.5mm / 60cm circular needles

Notions: Tapestry needle

Finished size: 70cm x 40cm

TIPS

In the brioche section, you will work only one color each round, alternating between one round of MC and one round of CC.

The slipped stitch and the yo from the previous round should always be counted as a single stitch.

All slipped stitches in the brioche section are worked purlwise and with the yarn in front.

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ABBREVIATIONS

MC = main color

CC = contrast color

k = knit

p = purl

yo = yarn over

sl1 = slip 1 stitch purlwise

wyif = with yarn in front

brk = knit the slipped stitch and yo from the previous round together

brp = purl the slipped stitch and yo from the previous round together

k2tog = knit 2 stitches together

p2tog = purl 2 stitches together

M1L = left leaning increase

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INSTRUCTIONS

CO 88 sts w/5.5mm needle and using MC.

Join to knit in the round and place a stitch marker to indicate the beginning of the round.

Ribbing

Work in k4, p4 ribbing for 7 rounds.

Knit 1 round.

Brioche section

Set-up round (work once)

Using CC, *sl1wyif, yo, p1*, rep from * to * to the end.

Brioche pattern

1 MC) *brk, sl1wyif, yo*, rep from * to * to the end.

2 CC) *sl1wyif, yo, brp*, rep from * to * to the end.

Repeat rounds 1) and 2) a total of 38 times.

Transition round

Using MC, *(brk, k1) x 10, k2tog*, rep from * to * to the end. (84 sts)

Lace section (work the written or charted instructions 4 times)

Written	Lace Chart
1) *k4, k2tog, yo*, rep from * to * to the end.	
2) *k3, k2tog, k1, yo*, rep from * to * to the end.	
3) *k2, k2tog, k2, yo*, rep from * to * to the end.	
4) *k1, k2tog, k3, yo*, rep from * to * to the end.	
5) *k2tog, k4, yo*, rep from * to * to the end.	
	<p>□ = knit / = k2tog ○ = yarn over</p>



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Transition round

(K21, M1L) x 4 (88sts).

Ribbing

Work in K4, p4 ribbing for 7 rounds.

Bind off all stitches loosely and weave in ends. A light blocking is all that's needed!
